What do our coaches look at during tryouts?

1. Coachable – Willing to learn, accept feedback, and continuously improve.
2. Hardworking – Gives maximum effort in every practice, workout, and match.
3. Competitive – Plays to win while embracing challenges and strong competition.
4. Disciplined – Maintains a positive attitude, follows team standards, and takes responsibility.
5. Respectful – Treats teammates, coaches, officials, opponents, and facilities with respect.
6. Resilient – Learns from mistakes, handles adversity, and never gives up.
7. Leadership – Leads by example through actions, communication, and accountability.
8. Positive Energy – Encourages teammates and contributes to a supportive team environment.

Commitment Process

- NYC Impact may send an offer any time after the first tryout.
- Once the offer is made, the offer remains valid exclusively for the day of the offer + 72 hours(3 full day)
- To secure your foster spot, you must submit a \$800 non refundable deposit.
- The commitment letter must signs by parents/guardians
- After you submitted the deposit and the letter, you are considered fully committed to NYC Impact for the 2026-2027 season. You are not allowed to tryout for or commit to another club.

Frequently asked questions about NYC Impact.

What are our coaches' qualifications?

- Our coaches are USAV Impact Certified
- USAV/AAU Background Checked
- SafeSport Certified
- Years of competitive club and college playing experience

When was NYC Impact established?

- NYC Impact was established on 2011 as a tiny club with only one girls team. Now, we have eight total GEVA teams across the boys and girls programs.
- We compete locally and nationally.

What level of tournaments do we participate in?

- We always take into consideration the strength of the teams we have and register the team to the level that they compete and a chance to win.



Frequently Asked Questions

Frequently asked questions about Practice Schedule.

When is the first practice?

- The first practice will take place in week of September 14th 2026.

No practice due to school closure for public holiday:

- Since we are using NYC DOE facilities, we are following the DOE calendar
- Thanksgiving day
- Christmas break(12/23/2026 to 1/1/2027) Regular practice resumes starting on 1/2/2027
- Public school mid-winter break 2/15-19, 2027
- Eid al-Fitr, Tuesday March 9th 2027
- Good Friday, March 26th 20027
- Spring Break, April 22-30, 2027

Frequently Asked Questions

Frequently asked questions about Tournaments.

Where are the single-day tournaments?

- They will be in the tri-state area within a 1-2 hour drive.
- Team members will travel to the tournament early in the morning and return home at the end of the tournament.

Is playing time guaranteed?

- Playtime is **NOT** guaranteed at any tournaments. Your membership does not pay for playing time, you are paying to learn the sport of volleyball. Playing time is earned during practice. Every player will get an equal opportunity at practice and at scrimmages.
- Please **DO NOT** approach the coach and discuss playing during a tournament at any time.
- If you have any questions regarding playing, please schedule a time with the coach to discuss the issue.

Frequently Asked Questions

Frequently asked questions about Tournaments.

Where are the multiple day tournaments?

- Overnight tournaments will be in Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Connecticut, and Massachusetts.

What if I am not able to take my son to a tournament or an overnight tournament?

- For a single-day tournament, parents can reach out to other parents in the team and see who has additional seats available and then coordinate with the parent who is driving on a pickup spot.
- For overnight tournaments, each team will have a team chaperone, the team chaperone will coordinate with other parents on carpooling, team meals, and snacks.
- Usually, chaperones collect a fixed amount for each overnight tournament, they will pay for breakfast, lunch, and/or dinner. If there are any leftover funds, this chaperone will pass it to the chaperone of the next tournament.

Frequently Asked Questions

Frequently asked questions about Tournaments.

Who is qualified to be a team chaperone?

- Any team dad, mom, or family member
- Chaperone needs to obtain USAV/GEVA chaperone membership, requires to be background checked, and complete the SafeSport Core training.
- The club will cover the chaperone's hotel expenses.

If I volunteer for Chaperone, do I have to do all overnight tournament?

- No, you can volunteer for the one you are able to.

Frequently Asked Questions

Frequently asked questions about Financial Aid.

Does NYC Impact offer financial aid?

- Yes, NYC Impact provides limited financial aid support.
- Please do not contact us regarding financial aid until after your daughter has received an official offer.

Do we provide a Payment Plan?

- Yes, we do provide a payment plan.
Plan A: $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$
Plan B: $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, and $\frac{1}{4}$
Plan C: 4 or more installments, addition \$50 service fee will be added to each installments. No more than 6 installments.
